No donkeys removed before payment after Sale. Donkeys must be removed by 8 PM. (We can help if you attend / phone bid, but won't have a trailer at the Sale.)

Bidding: All donkeys sell to the highest bidder. Any disputes or challenges will be settled by the auctioneer, and his decision will be final. The auctioneer may reject any or all bids. Bids are per lot. Jennets with foals on the side sell as one lot.
