The Lebanon Raceway, a private company, will be in operation, so no parking on paved areas. Parking for the Sale will be indicated.

From I-75, take exit #29 (Monroe, Lebanon, Rt 63) east to Lebanon, 7 miles. Turn left on Broadway (Rt 48 North), go 0.7 miles to the Fairground.

From I-71, take exit #28 (Rt 48), turn North, go about 2 miles to Rt 123, exit west toward Lebanon, go 1 mile, turn right on Broadway, go 0.7 miles to the Fairground

- Terms: Terms of the sale are cash or good check, with photo identification. All donkeys must be paid for immediately at sale end. No animals may be removed prior to close of the sale, and all donkeys must be removed from the premises by 8 PM, unless other arrangements have been made with the sponsors. (We can help you if you want to attend / phone bid, but won't have a trailer at the Sale. Call us.)
- **Bidding**: All donkeys sell to the highest bidder. Any disputes or challenges will be settled by the auctioneer, and his decision will be final. The auctioneer may reject any or all bids. Bids are per lot. Jennets with foals on the side sell as one lot.
- **Risk**: The owner assumes all risk for the donkey up to the point of sale. The buyer assumes all risk at the moment the auctioneer declares the animal is sold. The management is not responsible for loss or damages to personal property.
- Announcements: All announcements on sale day from the auction block will take precedence over the material printed in this catalog. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the catalog. However, we assume no liability for errors or omissions.
- **Contract**: The management, auctioneers, and employees act as agents for the seller, but assume no liability for either the buyer or the seller. Any representations made by the sales management are made on behalf of the seller.

- **Export** The buyer will assume all costs incurred for additional veterinary work, quarantine, shipping, and any necessary expenses. For further clarification, please contact us we export frequently.
